A meeting of South Petherwin Parish Council was held in the Methodist Hall on Wednesday April 10th 2013.

Representations from the Public No members of the public attended the meeting.

- 13/052 Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on March 13th were approved and signed, proposed by Cllr Mrs Tyler seconded by Cllr Mrs Archer.
- 13/053 Turbine at Trevozah Cross The Chairman reported that a meeting of the Community Benefit Trustees had decided to administer the funds themselves rather than employ 'Community Energy Plus' The Charity Commissioners are being contacted re registration. As Cllr Mrs Archer is standing down as a member of the council a new council representative will be nominated at the next meeting.
- 13/054 Roads Some of the potholes through the village have been filled, the ones in Daws House still have to be done. The Parish Clerk reported that she has asked for the rubbish on the sides of the road to be cleared. Cllr Mrs Archer asked if there was any news regarding signs for Tregaller Lane.
- 13/055 Play Area It is thought that agreement with the school is imminent.
- 13/056 Footpaths It was reported that the Kennards House footpath has been cleared. Mr Sanders quote for maintaining the footpaths this year is £300 plus £42 for each cut of the Trelinnoe Gardens footpath. This years agreement has not yet been received from Cornwall Council.
- 13/057 Church Clock The work will be carried out when the weather improves.
- 13/058 Pre School Fence The work has been completed and the invoice received.
- 13/059 Web Site Cllr Mrs Rogers reported that the council minutes will now appear on the website as soon as they have been approved by the council.
- 13/060 Launceston Community Network It was reported that an interesting debate on 'Green Energy' took place at a special meeting of the Community Network recently.
- 13/061 Wind Turbines The Parish Clerk reported on the Cornwall Council planning meeting held on March 25th. The application for a wind turbine at Beacon was rejected by a vote of 9 to 3. The Parish Clerk was thanked for speaking at the meeting her speech had been circulated to councillors. It is not yet known when the Kennards House turbine will go before the committee.
- 13/062 Core Strategy Document Cornwall Local Plan Councillors were disappointed that the Launceston Town Framework was not included in the Core Strategy

Document. Cllr Mrs Rogers and the Parish Clerk will compose a response to the document.

13/063 Old Road Restoration Project Cllr Parsons is not standing for Cornwall Council in the elections. Councillors hope that he will still carry on with the project.

13/064 Council Elections May 2nd Councillors Mrs Archer and Mrs Davies are not standing for the parish council. There are 10 people standing and 10 seats, therefore there will not be an election. The Parish Clerk read out the names of those who will form the new council.
