

## **SOUTH PETHERWIN PARISH COUNCIL**

A meeting of South Petherwin parish council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday September 11<sup>th</sup> 2013.

Representations from the public There were no members of the public present.

Declarations of Interest There were no declarations of interest.

- 13/139      Minutes The minutes of the August council meeting were approved and signed, proposed by Cllr Finnemore, seconded by Cllr Mrs Tyler.
- 13/140      Police Report PCSO Clair Danson reported that a lot of litter is being left in Tregaller Lane, PCSO Danson is in touch with Mrs Stoneham. There had been one offence in South Petherwin during the past month, a drink driver stopped on the B3254. There had been travellers in the parish but they did not stop. Several dogs have been stolen in the area and also some cattle stolen from Alternun. A speed watch will be undertaken with the school later in the year.  
A report of a rape at Tregadillett had subsequently not been as reported, the road through the village was closed for 24 hours.
- 13/141      Roads It was reported that the road side foliage on B3254 between Honiton and Trekelland Bridge has not been cut.
- 13/142      Old Road Restoration There is nor more news on this matter.
- 13/143      Community Benefit The trustees are to be contacted and updated.
- 13/144      Village Pump The work is still to be carried out.
- 13/145      Code of Conduct Consultation evenings are to be held in Truro and Bodmin. Copies of the book 'A Good Councillors Guide' have not yet been received.
- 13/146      Toilets The repainting has been carried out and the invoice received.
- 13/147      Cornwall Council Report Cllr Burden reported that budget consultation meetings are currently being held throughout the county.  
The funding of Adult Care in the county is to be altered, consultations are now taking place. There will be no limit on the funding for home care, the present limit is £250 per week.. The tenancy of 1 Trecrogo Lane End has been relinquished. Cllr Burden is to be in touch with the parish clerk to specify which roads are in need of repair.

13/148 Planning Appeal PA12/07455 Wind Turbine at Beacon. It was proposed by Cllr Screech that the parish clerk send a copy of her representation to the Cornwall Planning Committee to the Planning Inspector, proposal seconded by Cllr Mrs Tyler, proposal carried.

13/151 Pennygillam Industrial Estate A recent incident occurred on the Pennygillam Industrial Estate where it was feared that toxic gas would be released into the air. The businesses on the estate were given a warning but the residents living on the periphery of the estate were not warned. The emergence gates were opened to evacuate vehicles but the surface of the exit road is in need of repair. It was the opinion of councillors that if there is an emergency strategy for the industrial estate it was not put in force. It was proposed by Cllr Screech that letters be sent to the relevant officers at County Hall, proposal seconded by Cllr Kneebone, proposal carried.

13/152 Wind Turbine in Lezant Parish Cllr Screech reported on a meeting he had attended to discuss a proposed planning application for a wind turbine in Lezant parish but very close to the border with South Petherwin. Lezant parish wants to share any Community Benefit gained with South Petherwin. A meeting is to be arranged with Lezant parish council.

13/153 Parish Clerk's Resignation The parish clerk Mrs Fran Dennison had decided to retire and tendered her letter of resignation to the council. The position will be advertised in the Cornish & Devon Post, the Parish Magazine, the Parish Notice boards and the Job Centre.
