### **A30 Trebursye to Kennards House westbound resurfacing**

Highways England operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know that we will shortly be carrying out roadworks near to you. A map detailing the location is included within this letter.

#### **The works**

Inspection has revealed the road surface between A30 Trebursye and Kennards House westbound has deteriorated and needs to be replaced. By carrying out this work now we will maintain the network in good condition for our customers and avoid the need for disruptive unplanned closures in future. We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption which may occur.

#### **When**

**Dates:** 22 October to 2 November 2018

**Hours of work:** Overnight 8pm to 6am, week nights only

#### **Traffic management**

Where possible these works will be carried out under a convoy system. However the following closures will be necessary.

**22, 23 and 25 October** – overnight westbound carriageway closure between Trebursye and Kennards House. Traffic will be diverted off the A30 at Trebursye exit slip, follow the local road network via Tregadillett to re-join the A30 via the westbound on slip at Kennard's House.

**24 October 2018** – overnight Trebursye westbound exit slip closure. Those wishing to exit at this slip road will continue along the A30, leave at Kennard's House exit slip and return via the local road network.

Please note that whilst we always aim to work to the programme, **unforeseen circumstances may mean slight changes to it.** We will notify you of any major changes within the programme via advance roadside warning signs but please monitor [www.trafficengland.com](http://www.trafficengland.com) to keep up to date. We will make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to an absolute minimum.
