Pennygillam culvert is still a problem, further discussions are required. Cornwall Governance Review Panel have agreed 'no change' to the Pennygillam Industrial Estate boundary, recommendations will now go to public comment and to the Boundary commission. No changes at the old Kensey buildings and the building opposite Countryside Furnishers in Pennygillam Industrial Estate is being converted to a fast food takeaway. Trekelland Bridge has been hit again, as it is on the Historic England at risk list, a letter should be written to the Cabinet Member and Leader of Cornwall Council. Repair work on the bridge will commence on 22nd February 2021.</p>
